### **The Story**

**"In America"** tells the story of Mr. Johnson, a recent teaching graduate from NYU who lands his first teaching assignment, **"The Interview Song,"** as an English as a Second Language (ESL) teacher to immigrants at a local community college in San Francisco, CA. The show provides a window into one aspect of immigrant life often overlooked, that of immigrants as English language students, **"Student Introduction Song"**. The opening number, **"Education,"** presents a large and diverse cast of Board of Ed members, teachers, students and **"Thug Boys"** who introduce themselves to the audience by offering their own unique views on the subject amid growing budget and anti-immigrant woes which threaten the school's future.

Outside the sanctuary of the classroom, ICE raids and Thug Boy attacks cause fear among the immigrant community while inside, the students write and sing of their **"Daydreams"**. Additionally, a beleaguered Mr. Johnson must contend with one amorous student whose romantic interest in the young teacher complicates preparations for his class's final test, one he sees as a measure of his own teaching skills, **"It's Their Big Test (Or Is It Mine?")**.
